### Steps to Salvation

**John 10:10** – The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

**Ecclesiastes 7:20** – For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

**John 14:6** – Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

**John 1:12** – But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.

**Ephesians 2:8-9** – For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

**Revelation 3:20** – Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

### What We Believe

**What does the Bible say about the Authority of the Scripture?** The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. **Psalms 19:7-8**

**What does the Bible say about who Jesus is?** He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. **Matthew 16:15-16**

**What does the Bible say about our mission on earth?** Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen. **Matthew 28:19-20**

**What does the Bible say about sharing your story of faith?** But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. **Acts 1:8**

**What does the Bible say about Believer's Baptism?** Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. **Romans 6:4**

**What does the Bible say about obeying authority?** Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God; the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. **Romans 13:1-2**

**What does the Bible say about your money?** Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. **2 Corinthians 9:7**

**What does the Bible say about our relationship to God?** But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. **1 Peter 2:9**

**What does the Bible say about the Security of the Believer?** For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 8:38-39**

**What does the Bible say about holiness?** Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. **1 Peter 1:16**

### A Psalm of Praise

**1** Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. **2** Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. **3** Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. **4** Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. **5** For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations. **Psalm 100**

### God Knows Me

**1** O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me. **2** Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. **3** Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. **4** For there is not a word in my tongue, but lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether. **5** Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me. **6** Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it. **7** Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? **8** If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. **Psalm 139:1-8**

### The Beatitudes

**3** Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. **4** Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. **5** Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. **6** Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. **7** Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. **8** Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. **9** Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. **10** Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. **11** Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. **12** Rejoice, and be exceeding glad, for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

### The First Lord's Supper

**17** And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves: **18** For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come. **19** And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. **20** Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you. **Luke 22:17-20**

### A Christian's Armor

**13** Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. **14** Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; **15** And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; **16** Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. **17** And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: **18** Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints. **Ephesians 6:13-18**

**19** Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: **20** For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. **21** Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. **22** But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. **James 1:19-22**
